



 Schedule routine inspections to detect wear and tear early.
 Check for leaks, alignment, and unusual noises to address potential issues before they escalate.

MANTAIN CLEAN FUEL

Use high-quality diesel fuel and ensure the fuel tank is clean to avoid contamination. Regularly inspect and replace fuel filters to protect the engine from impurities.



MONITOR COOLING SYSTEM

Overheating is a common issue in diesel engines. Ensure the cooling system is functioning properly by checking coolant levels and cleaning radiators to prevent blockages.



TEST RUN THE PUMP REGULARLY

Periodic test runs keep the pump components operational and identify any performance issues. Follow NFPA 25 guidelines for weekly or monthly testing.
